Dear JUMC family,

LENT is a time for growing deeper in our faith in God as we confess and repent of our sins on the way to the Cross of Christ. The wages



of sin is death. We deserve to die on that Cross, but He took our sin upon Himself and died there in our stead. What wondrous love is this!

One way to grow deeper in faith is a Scripture Search Game. It can be enjoyable and enriching at the same time. It makes the internet "search" box a tool for Christ and His Church!

Here is one of my recent works. I began with Matthew 11:28 and searched: "When did Jesus say, 'Come?"

Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

COME = Like a toddler runs with arms wide



open and shouting their name when their parent arrives, Jesus' arms are wide open to receive us whether we COME running or barely able to move. Jesus says, COME.

TO = Because Jesus invited in TO Paradise even the repenting prisoner who hung on a cross beside Him; surely Jesus invites every one of us. Repent and be saved. Luke 23:43

ME = JESUS is the Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Isaiah 9:6.

ALL = There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are ALL one in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:28

YOU = For God did not send his Son into the WORLD to condemn the WORLD, but to save the WORLD through Him. John 3:17

WHO = For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, thatWHOEVER believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

ARE = Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. Hebrews 13:8



WEARY and BURDENED=

This Lent, especially with COVID lasting over a year, and all the tension in our lives, we can't pretend we are all is fine and doing well! We must grieve in order to be well in the future.

Naming our reasons for grief helps overcome their power to cause us pain.

We grieve loss of close relationship, fellowship, visiting with one another, our good health, our jobs, our ability to travel. We grieve the loss of time that has past and events we have missed! We grieve the uncertainties of the future.

AND = Jesus promised: I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you AND the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My Name, will teach you all things AND will remind you of everything I have said to you. John 14: 18. 26.

I = Early in His ministry, Jesus asked His disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" And Simon Peter answered, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." Matthew 16:16. Do a "search" for "Names of Jesus" and immerse yourself in His wondrous attributes.

WILL = Do another "search," this time type in "Jesus WILL." The promises of Christ WILL fill your cup to overflowing with all the promises of God through Christ. "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if anyone hears My Voice, and open the door, I WILL come in to them, and WILL sup with them, and they with Me." Revelation 3:20.

GIVE = When I picture Jesus dying on the Cross, I see the FREE GIFT of God's grace in Christ reconciling the world unto Himself. I sing, "He said, 'Freely, freely, you have received; freely, freely GIVE."

YOU = John wrote, I am writing these things to YOU so that YOU may not sin. But IF ANYONE does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the WHOLE WORLD. 1 John 2:1-29

REST. = This is the same Matthew 27:28-29 verses from the new *Passion Translation of the Bible*. I like its imagery.

Are you weary, carrying a heavy burden? Then come to Me. I will refresh your life, for I am your Oasis. Simply join your life with Mine. Learn My ways and you'll

discover that I'm gentle, humble, easy to please. You will find refreshment & rest in Me.

Matthew 27:28-29

I breathed a sigh of relief at the word, "oasis." And then again at "refreshment and rest." Did you? Hope you enjoyed this Biblical "game" to deepen your faith in God during this unusual & unprecedented Lent. Let me know what you discover on your Biblical "searches."

This will allow us to observe the Sacrament of the Lord's Table TOGETHER & LIVE, as allowed by Iowa Conference UMC policy during COVID.


We're sorry for any inconvenience, but are doing our best to offer all viewers the ability to worship "virtually," as it is called.

Iowa United Methodist Women Ignited for Justice – Mission u 2021


"But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream." (ESV) Amos 5:24
