Dear JUMC Family and Friends,

Effective June 30, Pastor Audrey has retired, and the Conference is in the process of finding a new, full-time pastor for Janesville/Hudson. In the meantime, we are filling our pulpit each Sunday with volunteer "Circuit Riders". These Circuit Riders are a group of Lay Speakers and Ministers who reach out to help churches in our area when they are without a Minister.

These Lay Speakers will be able to do Communion for us, as they will bring the elements of the Eucharist with them, since they must be recently blessed by a Minister. We will have Communion the 1st Sunday of each month, as usual, as will Hudson. The Lay Speakers do not do Baptisms, Weddings, or Funerals. If we should be unable to secure a speaker, we will do a Hymn sing that Sunday.

If you have any suggestions, questions, or concerns about how things are going during this time, please feel free to share. We are in this together and we will be doing some things a bit differently as we move forward.
